DEATH OF SISTER FLORENCE CORMIER (1927-2018)



Sister Florence Cormier, n.d.s.c., in religion Sr Marie-Jeannine-Thérèse, of Maison-Mère des Religieuses Notre-Dame-du-Sacré-Coeur, Moncton, passed away following a lengthy illness on Thursday November 1st, 2018 at the convent where she resided. She was 91 years old and in her 73rd year of her religious life. Born February 14, 1927 in St-Paul, she was the daughter of the late Edmond and Lina (Dionne) Cormier.

Besides her religious family, she is survived by four sisters: Anita Bourgeois (late Armand) of Dieppe, Phyllis Maillet (Léandre) of Leominster, Massachusetts, Sr Stella, n.d.s.c. of Moncton and Sr Jeannine, n.d.s.c. of Grand-Sault; one brother, Oscar (Lorette) of Shediac; several nieces and nephews.

Besides her parents, she was predeceased by three sisters: Yvonne, Dorice, and Émilie; four brothers: Adélarde (Élodie), Henri (Clara), Yvon (Doris), and Joseph.

The funeral of Sister Cormier took place today, November 5th, in the Maison-Mère chapel and the interment will be in Memramcook.
