## PARISH OFFICIALS

Since August 15, 1999, the pastoral charge of parishes has been the responsibility of pastoral teams. I praise God for the wonderful collaboration given and for the work which this team approach to ministry has accomplished. For 2004-2005, though there may be little change in the makeup of these pastoral teams, it is important to consolidate these teams that are called to move forward into new areas of endeavour, by determining further specific tasks within the team, and by carrying out the pastoral restructuring proposed, for pastoral unity. Let us remember that within the parish pastoral team, because of his ordination the priest moderator represents Christ the Head of the Church. As such, he presides the celebration of the sacraments, proclaims the Word, and ensures the unity of the community confided to his care. The priest moderator shall meet with his whole pastoral team at least monthly, and attend meetings of the deanery or pastoral zone. Besides, the priest moderator is the living link between the members of his community and the Bishop of the diocese, and it is incumbent on the priest moderator to pass on to those concerned what he has received from the Bishop, and to the Bishop the greetings, recommendations, and views of the community.
